Vendors are allowed to stay open later than 6pm but must be off the field by 8pm. Vendors must be responsible for their own garbage and cleanup.

Licenses/Certifications:

A certificate of insurance is required with Pacific Events District listed as an additional insured. General liability must be at least \$1,000,000.

The City of Long Beach requires Vendors to be in compliance with all applicable regulations regarding their products. If you gross more than \$12,000 a year (or, if you gross less but need one or more specialty licenses), you must obtain a Master Business License from the State of Washington Department of Licensing (DOL). You may need one or more specialty licenses; make sure to apply early. Please indicate below the licenses, certifications, and/or permits you have. **All documents must be received by JUNE 11th. You must include a copy of each document that applies to you.**
